You should expect the following costs to be added to your PhilaU Student Account:

¹ These housing costs are estimates and are subject to exchange rate fluctuations between the British Pound and the US Dollar.

The costs below will not be on your PhilaU Student Account, but are costs we recommend you budget for:

Round-trip Airfare¹ = \$1,000 - \$1,400 (approximate range) Meals² = \$400 - 600 / month (approximate range) Public transit³ = \$200 / month Local Cell Phone and Plan= \$40 per month (international plan and phone is higher) Personal Expenses⁴ = \$2,000 - \$5,000 (approximate range)

- ¹ Flight is booked independently by the student after he/she receives an acceptance notification by the University of Westminster. Dates for booking the flight will be provided upon acceptance.
- ² The University of Westminster does not have a meal plan. Students will purchase their own food and prepare their food at home in their residence hall (equipped with kitchen). Cost is based on assumption that students will eat in and eat out (on occasion).
- ³ Public transportation is essential in a big city like London. Students will be expected to purchase monthly transit passes for daily use of the bus system and underground metro.
- ⁴ This cost represents money that student will likely spend on weekend travel, personal shopping, school supplies, public transportation, etc. This expense varies drastically per student, hence the broad range. We recommend discussing a realistic budget for these expenses as a family!

Financial Aid Information:

For the costs listed above that will be added to your PhilaU Student Account, your PhilaU financial aid package will be applied as usual*. Should you need to request additional aid to help cover your study abroad fees, depending on your eligibility, you may have an opportunity to increase your aid (primarily loans) prior to receiving your university bill.
