Expected/Approximate Costs for 2018

You should expect the following costs to be added to your PhilaU Student Account:

These costs are subject to change at the discretion of all applicable parties involved

Tuition: DIS Fee Per Term (6 Credit Arch Studio: \$5825, Furniture: \$7,025)

DIS Housing = \$2,875

International Medical Insurance = \$88 (based on 2016 policy rates)

PhilaU Study Abroad Administrative Fee = \$500

The costs below will not be on your PhilaU Student Account, but are estimated additional costs that you should budget for:

Round-trip Airfare = \$1,000 - \$1,500 (approximate range)

Meals* = approximately \$100 / week

Personal Expenses** = approximately \$100 / week

**The DIS program does not have a meal plan. Students will purchase their own food and prepare their food at home.*

***This cost represents money that student will likely spend on personal travel, personal shopping, entertainment, etc. This expense tends to vary a lot per student based on your lifestyle and what you plan to do.*

Financial Aid Information:

Summer financial aid is a separate application process from the financial aid you may receive for your fall and spring semester fees. Should you need additional funding to help cover your summer study abroad fees, depending on your eligibility, you may have an opportunity to receive aid (primarily loans), which would be applied to your university summer bill.
